



Currency Creek Estate is one of the jewels of the Fleurieu Peninsula, near the Adelaide Hills in South Australia. The Adelaide Hills where these grapes are grown produces exceptional parcels of these varieties as it enjoys a long cool ripening period—Perfect for producing wines of delicate fruit characters.



TASTING NOTE

The dominant Pinot Noir component produces a pretty pink tinge while adding an array of strawberry and cherry flavours. Fruit depth and texture is a contribution of the Chardonnay. Leading to a long lively and creamy finish.

VINTAGE 2023

Average winter rainfall followed by cooler than average spring and summer conditions resulted in a prolonged but well-balanced vintage for the Currency Creek Wine Region.

White varieties benefited from some early cooler climatic conditions and the maritime influence of Currency Creek, these conditions resulted in excellent quality, good fruit ripeness and naturally balanced acidity.

Regional yields were 5-20% below expected estimates overall, particularly lower in some reds, however largely 2023 yields were in line with historical yield expectations for whites.
